





### Confidentiality

By law, Statistics Canada is prohibited from releasing any information it collects that could identify any person, business, or organization, unless consent has been given by the respondent, or as permitted by the *Statistics Act*. Statistics Canada will use the information from this survey for statistical purposes only.

# **Data-sharing agreements**

To reduce respondent burden, Statistics Canada has entered into data-sharing agreements with provincial and territorial statistical agencies and other government organizations, which have agreed to keep the data confidential and use them only for statistical purposes. Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

**Section 11** of the *Statistics Act* provides for the sharing of information with provincial and territorial statistical agencies that meet certain conditions. These agencies must have the legislative authority to collect the same information, on a mandatory basis, and the legislation must provide substantially the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of confidential information as the *Statistics Act*. Because these agencies have the egal authority to compel businesses to provide the same information, consent is not requested and businesses may not object to the sharing of the data.

For this survey, there are **Settic.** 11 agreements with the provincial and tentorial statistical agreement of Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quobes Ontario, Maritoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, Eritish Columbia, and the Yukon.

**Section 12** of the *Statistics Act* provides for the sharing of information with federal, provincial or territorial government organizations. Under **Section 12**, you may refuse to share your information with any of these organizations by writing a letter of objection to the Chief Statistician and returning it with the completed questionnaire. Please specify the organizations with which you do not want to share your data.

For this survey, there are **Section 12** agreements with the statistical agencies of Prince Edward Island, Northwest Territories and Nunavut, as well as with Québec Forest Industry Council, the Ministère des Forêts, de la Faune et des Parcr cu Québec, the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resource and Forestry, Manitoba Dona tment of Sustaina de Development, the Saskat heway Ministry of the Economy, Alberta Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, British Columbia Ministry of Forests, Lancs and Natural Resource Or erations and Natural Resources Canada.

For agreements with provincial and territorial government erganizations, the shared data will be limited to information pertaining to business establishments located within the jurisdiction of the respective province or territory.
