

Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

Under **Section 12** of the *Statistics Act*, respondents can object to the sharing of information with other organizations. However, respondents do not have the right of refusal with respect to sharing the data with Transport Canada. Transport Canada has the legislative authority to collect and use this information pursuant to the *Canada Transportation Act* (CTA) and the *Transportation Information Regulations*.

Respondents may refuse to share their information with Natural Resources Canada and the Canadian Transportation Agency by writing a letter of objection to the Chief Statistician and returning it with the completed questionnaire. These organizations have agreed to keep the data confidential and use them only for statistical purposes.
