## PRIMARY AND SPECIALIST CARE




This new survey collects important information on the experiences of Canadians with the health care system and on whether their needs are being met.

### You will be asked questions such as:

- Do you have a regular health care provider?
- How did you feel about the care you received?
- Have you accessed health care services in the last 12 months?
- Did you face any barriers?

Your participation will provide valuable insight into the use of health care services. All levels of government and health care planners across the country may use the survey results to make informed decisions about the delivery of health care services and to develop and improve health care programs and policies that better serve all Canadians.



- Has a regular health care provider
- Of those with a regular health care provider, the usual wait time for an appointment with their provider or another provider from the same office for a minor health problem is three days or less
- Perceived health (good, very good or excellent)
