The reliability of the data was reported using the following convention for quality indicator interpretation. This convention combines the effect of sampling (since we did not do a census).

The reliability of the data was reported using the following symbol convention:

Symbol	Meaning	Coefficient of variation	Standard error
A	Very reliable	$\leq 5.0\%$	$\leq 2.5\%$
B	Reliable	$> 5.0\%$ and $\leq 15.0\%$	$> 2.5\%$ and $\leq 7.5\%$
E	Use with caution	$> 15.0\%$ and $\leq 30.0\%$	> 7.5 and $\leq 15.0\%$
F	Too unreliable to be published	$> 30.0\%$	$> 15.0\%$
