Response Rates

Of the 24,443 nurses selected to participate in the survey, 1,015 were classified as being out-of-scope, meaning that they were not employed in nursing at the time of the survey. Of the remaining 23,428 sampled nurses, 18,676 completed the survey, for a response rate of 80%. Response rates by type of nurse were as follows:

- 80.8% registered nurses
- 78.4% licensed practical nurses
- 80.6% registered psychiatric nurses

Response rates by province/territory of registration are shown below. The data were weighted to adjust for differences in response rates by type of nurse and by province/territory.
