

The target population consists of all statistical establishments (sometimes referred to as firms or units) classified as Non Automotive Repair and Maintenance Services according to the North American Industry Classification System 1997 (NAICS 1997) during the reference year.

Repair and Maintenance services excluding automotive are included under the following seven codes:

811210 Electronic and Precision Equipment Repair and Maintenance

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in repairing, maintaining and calibrating electronic equipment and precision instruments.

Inclusions:

- Electrical measuring instrument
- Electronic equipment
- Nautical and navigational instrument
- Industrial process control equipment
- Photographic equipment
- Stereo equipment
- Precision instruments
- Televisions
- Computers and related equipment

Exclusions: Establishments primarily engaged in:

- rewinding armatures and rebuilding electric motors (Electrical Equipment Manufacturing);
- retailing new electronics and also providing repair services (Appliance, Television and Other Electronic Stores); and
- installing and repairing locks (Security Systems Services).

811310 Commercial and Industrial Machinery and Equipment (except Automotive and Electronic) Repair and Maintenance

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in repairing and maintaining commercial and industrial machinery and equipment, except automotive and electronic.

Inclusions:

- Blacksmith service
- Reconditioning shipping containers and metal drums
- Construction machinery and equipment
- Non-domestic cooling and refrigeration equipment
- Fire extinguishers
- Tank and boiler cleaning
- Industrial equipment and machinery
- Welding
- Electric motors

Exclusions: Establishments primarily engaged in:
rewinding armatures and rebuilding electric motors (Electrical Equipment Manufacturing);
repairing aircraft, railroad cars and engines and ships at the factory, shipyard, hangar, yard or dry dock (Aerospace Products and Parts, Other Support Services for Air, Rail and Water Transportation, Railroad Rolling Stock Manufacturing, and Ship and Boat Building).

811411 Home and Garden Equipment Repair and Maintenance

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in repairing and maintaining home and garden equipment.

Inclusions:

Hedge and lawn trimmers
Small gas engines
Lawn and garden equipment
Snow and leaf blowers
Outboard boat motors

Exclusion: Establishments primarily engaged in:
retailing outdoor power equipment and also providing repair services (Outdoor Power Equipment Stores).

811412 Appliance Repair and Maintenance

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in repairing and maintaining household appliances, without retail sales of new equipment.

Inclusions:

Self-contained air conditioning units
Power tools
Household appliances
Sewing machines

Exclusions: Establishments primarily engaged in:
retailing new appliances and also providing repair services (Appliance, Television and Other Electronics Stores);
repairing motor vehicle air-conditioning equipment (All Other Automotive Repair and Maintenance);
repairing consumer electronics (Electronic and Precision Equipment Repair and Maintenance); and
repairing commercial refrigeration equipment (Commercial and Industrial Machinery and Equipment with the exception of Automotive and Electronic repair and maintenance).

811420 Reupholstery and Furniture Repair

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged reupholstering, refinishing, repairing, and restoring furniture, without retail sales of new furniture.

Inclusions:

Reupholstering
Polishing
Stripping and refinishing
Repairing

Exclusions: Establishments primarily engaged in:

making furniture and custom cabinets (Furniture and Related Product Manufacturing);
retailing upholstery materials (Sewing, Needlework and Piece Goods Stores);
restoring museum pieces (Independent Artists, Writers and Performers); and
repairing motor vehicle interiors (Automotive Body, Paint, Interior and Glass Repair).

811430 Footwear and Leather Goods Repair

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in repairing footwear and/or other leather or leather-like goods, such as handbags and briefcases.

Inclusions:

Boots and shoes
Luggage
Leather goods

Exclusion: Establishments primarily engaged in retailing luggage and leather goods and also providing repair services (Luggage and Leather Goods Stores).

811490 Other Personal and Household Goods Repair and Maintenance

This Canadian industry comprises establishments, not classified to any other industry, primarily engaged in repairing and maintaining personal and household goods, without retail sales of new equipment.

Inclusions:

Bicycles
Musical instruments
Garment repair
Restoration and repair of antiques (except furniture and automobiles)
Gunsmith shops

Saw and lawn mower blades, knife and scissors sharpening

Motorcycles

Jewellery, clock and watch repair and engraving
