Authority: This survey is conducted under the authority of the Statistics Act, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19. Completion of this questionnaire is a legal requirement under the Statistics Act.

Confidentiality : Information collected under the Statistics Act is treated in strict confidence and is specifically exempt from being released under the Access to Information Act. The data reported on this questionnaire are used for statistical purposes, and are published in aggregate form only.

Purpose of the survey : The aim of this survey is to compile data on all international transactions in services directly bought and sold abroad by businesses located in Canada. Please, **include** transactions conducted between the Canadian entity (surveyed by this questionnaire) and foreign related parties. However, **do not include** transactions between foreign related parties and non-related parties or transactions between two foreign related parties located outside Canada. This survey is **not** intended for : imports and exports of goods, freight and shipping transactions, travel, interest or profit/loss. The data are required for the compilation of Canada's Balance of International Payments and the Gross Domestic Product. Such statistics are used as a major input in the conduct of monetary and exchange rate policies. Other uses of these data include the development and monitoring of international trade agreements, and for business planning, marketing and institutional research.

Reporting entity : The reporting corporation should report for itself and all of its subsidiaries located in Canada.

Geographic detail : Please use enclosed coding list to identify country. When geographical distribution is not available, please estimate. (If there are any difficulties in reporting the geographical breakdown by country, specify individual countries only for those amounts greater than \$500,000.)

Commercial services transactions : **Commercial services** include such activities as royalties, rights, computer services, management or administrative fees, research and development, engineering, technical and other consulting/professional services, insurance premiums and claims (settled), commissions, advertising, equipment rentals (except financial leases) and other services.

Coverage : Report amounts directly remitted or charged to accounts, settled by issue of stock, notes, etc. to creditor, net of withholding tax. Excluded are real estate rentals or sales, freight and shipping transactions, interest, dividends, public subsidies, and all sales of physical goods.
