These agencies must have the legislative authority to collect the same informatic. On a mandatory basis, and the legislation must provide substantially the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for on closure of confidential information as the *Statistics Act*. Because these agencies have the legal authority to compel by increases to provide the same information, consent is not requested and businesses may not object to the sharing of the data.

For this survey, there are **Section 11** agreements with the provincial and territorial statistic. I age icies of Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, Dritish Columbia, and the Yukon.

The shared data will be limited to information pertaining to business establishments located within the jurisdiction of the respective province or territory.

Under **Section 12**, you may refuse to share your information with any of these organizations by writing a letter of objection to the Chief Statistician and returning it with the completed questionnaire. For agreements with provincial and territorial governmen, organizations, the shared data will be limited to information pertaining to business establishments located within the jurisdiction of the respective province or territory.
