#### **Data-Sharing Agreements**

In order to reduce response burden and to provide consistent statistics, Statistics Canada has entered into data sharing agreement with the statistical agencies of Quebec, Manitoba and British Columbia in accordance with Section 11 of the *Statistics Act*, Revised Statutes of Canada, 1985, Chapter S19. For business locations operated in Quebec, Manitoba and British Columbia, the agreement authorize Statistics Canada to forward a record of the data collected in this survey to the statistical agencies of these provinces. The Statistics Acts of these provinces include the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of information as the federal *Statistics Acts*.
