#### Confidentiality

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from releasing and information it collects which could identify any person. business, or organization, unless consent has been given by the respondent or as permitted by the Static ic. Act, including paragraph 17(2)(g). The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by either the Access to Information Act or any other legislation. Therefore, for example, the Canada Revenue ryout cannot access identifiable survey records from Statis ics Canada.

#### Fax or Other Electronic Trans nission Disclosure

### **Federal Provincial Data Sharing Agreements**

To avoid duplication and ease the burden on respondents, Statistics Canada has entered into agreements for this survey:

A. Under section 11 of the Statistics Act with the Newfoundland and Labrador Statistics Agency and the Québec Statis ics Institute. Statistics Canada only enters into section 1 agre, ments with provincial statistical agencies that have statictics acts similar to the federal act. These agencies have the authority to collect this information and the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of information as the Federal Statistics Act.

B. Under **section 12** of the *Statistics Act* with the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Transportation and Works, the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board, the Quebec Department of Transportation, the Ontario Ministry of Transportation and Transport Canada (see section C below). These agencies are required to keep the information confidential and only use it for statistical and research purposes. Under section 12, respondents may object to the sharing of their information by giving notice in writing to the Chief Statistician and returning their letter of objection along with the completed questionnaire.

C. Under **section 12** of the *Statistics Act* with Transport Canada for the sharing of information from this survey. This information is required by Transport Canada and collected from federally regulated carriers under the authority of the Canada Transportation Act and pursuant to the Carriers and Transportation and Grain Handling Undertakings Information Regulations. Under section 12 of the Statistics Act, nonfederally regulated carriers may refuse to share their information with Transport Canada by giving notice in writing to the Chief Statistician and returning their letter of objection along with the completed questionnaire.
