

These agencies must have the legislative authority to collect the same information, on a mandatory basis, and the legislation must provide substantially the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for disclosure of confidential information as the Statistics Act. The shared data will be limited to information pertaining to business establishments located within the jurisdiction of the respective province or territory.
