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DATA-SHARING AGREEMENTS

To reduce respondent burden, Statistics Canada has entered into data-sharing agreements with provincial and territorial statistical agencies and other government organizations, which have agreed to keep the data confidential and use them only for statistical purposes. For this survey, there are **Section 12** agreements with the New Brunswick Department of Agriculture, Aquaculture and Fisheries and the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs.
