

#### Confidentiality

### Your answers are confidential.

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from releasing any information it collects which could identify any person, business or organization, unless consent has been given by the respondent or as permitted by the *Statistics Act*. The confidentiality provision of the *Statistics Act* are not affected by either the *Access to Information Act* or any other legislation. Therefore, for example, the Canada Revenue Agency cannot access identifiable survey records from Statistics Canada.

Information from this survey will be used for statistical purposes only and will be published in aggregate form only.

# **Record linkages**

To enhance the data from this survey, Statistics Canada may combine it with information from other surveys or from administrative sources.

## **Data-sharing agreements**

To avoid duplication of enquiry, Statistics Canada has entered into data-sharing agreements with provincial statistical agencies, which must keep the data confidential and use them only for statistical purposes. Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

**Section 11** of the *Statistics Act* provides for the sharing of informa on with rovincial statistical agencies that meet certain conditions. These agencies must have the legislative authority to collect the same information, on a mandatory basis, and the legislation must provide substantially the same provisions for confidentiality and operations as the *Statistics Act*. Because these agencies have the legal authority compel businesses to provide the same information, consent is not requested and farm operations may not object to the sharing of heir contains the statistical agencies that meet certain conditions.
