Section 11 agreements exist with the statistical agencies of Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, British Columbia, and the Yukon. Section 12 of the Statistics Act provides for the sharing of information with federal, provincial or territorial government organizations. For this survey, Section 12 agreements exist with the statistical agencies of Prince Edward Island, the Northwest Territories and Nunavut. Under Section 12, you may refuse to share your information with any of these organizations by writing a letter of objection to the Chief Statistician and returning it with the completed questionnaire.
