

CENSUS COLLECTION IS UNDERWAY IN INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES

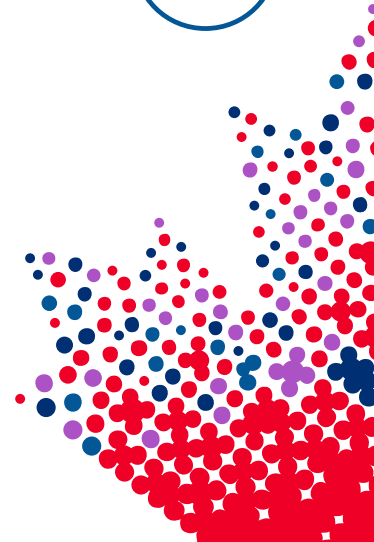
It's not too late! There is still time to complete the census.

- Census information is important and can help communities plan services such as child care, education, and health care.
- Households in Indigenous communities have received a census invitation letter that provides instructions on completing the questionnaire online.
- Census employees are in communities to help households complete their questionnaire.
- The census questions are available in **15 Indigenous languages** for reference purposes.
- All information is collected under the authority of the *Statistics Act* and will be kept strictly confidential.



Need assistance?

Census employees are visiting households to follow up and offer assistance with completing the 2026 Census questionnaire. Census employees will clearly identify themselves and have an identification card.
